This is the Official Call for Board Candidates for Our Elections and the Announcement of an Upcoming Annual Meeting in April

The Annual Meeting for the Windsor Lakes Homeowners' Association, Inc, is set for Wednesday, April 24th at 7:00 PM in Windsor Lodge. This required Annual Meeting is your best opportunity to learn the state of your Association with reports on finances, projects and activities of the past association year. Each homeowner-household will receive details of the meeting with a meeting agenda in the mail during the first week of April. A quorum of 25% of homeowners is required to conduct the business at this meeting.



The day prior to the Annual Meeting, Tuesday, April 23rd, an election will be held to select two Board members for Board positions that are expiring. This is the official call for candidates. Upon election, a Board member will serve a three-year term. The five-member Board, following the announcement of the election results, will meet in executive session and elect officers and assign responsibilities.

You are urged to consider being a candidate, or if you know of a neighbor who you believe would be qualified and be an asset to the community as a Board member, urge them to become a candidate. Self-nomination is the process to become a candidate. Any homeowner interested in running for the Board may nominate himself or herself by completing a WLHOA Board of Directors Nomination Application Form which is included with this newsletter, or an application can be downloaded from the Windsor Lakes website. Application forms are also now available at the Windsor Lodge Clubhouse reception desk. Instructions for submission of nomination on all qualified nominees will be published in an April mail-out announcement describing the Annual Meeting and Election.

There will be a "Meet the Candidate" meeting for homeowners at the Clubhouse on Tuesday, April 2nd, during which the candidates will be available for person-to-person interaction. Candidate biographical information will be available at the Clubhouse as well.

The election will be conducted in accordance with our WLHOA governing documents and will follow the election processes used in in the past. FirstService Residential will administer the election process and a team of Windsor Lakes homeowner volunteers will coordinate and oversee the election.

Volunteers to assist with the election are needed. Those interested in volunteering can sign up at the Clubhouse.

Please consider using your time and talents to serve your community on the WLHOA Board of Directors by submitting your nomination. There is one regular Board of Directors meeting prior to the Annual Meeting and it will be held on Tuesday, March 26th at 7 p.m. All homeowners are invited.
